




# **The Third Sunday of Easter** *Misericordia Domini* + April 14, 2024 + 9:00 A.M.

Welcome to the Lord's Day. Who are the "other sheep" to which Jesus refers in today's Gospel? We know that Jesus had previously warned about false prophets, men who were likened to "ferocious wolves" in sheep's clothing (Matthew 7:15). And prior to sending out the Twelve Apostles, a foretaste of later missionary ventures, Jesus likened their calling as being sent out "like sheep among wolves" (Matthew 10:16). If Jesus has come to reconcile all sinners to the Father by his blood and resurrection, could some of those very "wolves," in fact, be "sheep"?

# DISTRIBUTION
